

Gift Aid declaration

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Are you a UK taxpayer? If so, you can use Gift Aid to make your donations (and eligible membership fees) go further by completing this declaration. If you Gift Aid your donation, Tourettes Action will continue to receive an additional 28p. Charities can claim Gift Aid tax relief of 25p on every pound you give. HMRC will also operate transitional provisions for Gift Aid donations made from 6 April 2008 until 5 April 2011, paying a Government supplement of 3p on every pound you give. Tax claimed by Tourettes Action ✱ Tourettes Action will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008. ✱ Tourettes Action will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6 April 2008. ✱ The Government will pay to Tourettes Action an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for the charity does not affect your personal tax position.
